

Sacred Heart School exemplifies the importance of living the message of the Gospel by helping others. We believe that service to school and community is an integral part of a Catholic education.

All 8th grade students are required to complete **20 hours** of community service.

A "Student Record of Community Service Hours" form must be completed for each organization you volunteer at. All service hours must be recorded on the Sacred Heart School Student Record of Community Service Hours Form. Additional forms are available in the school office. Students must keep a copy of the forms submitted for their own records. (Students intending to apply for admission to the National Junior Honor Society will be asked for verification of service hours).

Acceptable volunteer service must be done for Non-Profit Community Organizations (501c3). Students can also complete their Community Service Hours by helping out in our aftercare program Monday-Friday from 3:30 pm-6:00 pm.

Volunteering at businesses, profitable organizations or for other individuals (babysitting, helping siblings with homework, helping a neighbor or friend, etc) is not considered acceptable service.

Falsifying any information on the Student Record of Community Service Hours form, or any other record of community service, will be treated as a violation of the Honor Code of Sacred Heart School.

Wherever and whenever community service is rendered, students represent themselves, their families, and Sacred Heart School. Proper appearance, attitude, behavior and language must be observed at all times. Students who fail to comply may face disciplinary measures as per the Sacred Heart School Student-Parent Handbook, and their service hours may not be counted.

All community service hours must be turned in to your Religion teacher on or before **April 30, 2017**. Failure to complete the hours may result in a grade reduction in the 4th quarter religion grade.
